2025

→ **Noorderhaven, Julianadorp**

A green, enclosed location with residential units, facilities such as a general practitioner, dentist, and riding school, as well as a petting zoo where animals play a central role in daytime activities.



→ **Boldershof, Druten**

Located in the heart of a residential neighborhood, there is always something happening, close to amenities, parks, and the River Waal.



→ **Willem van den Bergh, Noordwijk**

A spacious park on the outskirts of Noordwijk where people of all ages live, work, and enjoy recreational activities together.



→ **Groot Schuylenburg, Apeldoorn**

A green, versatile park where people live, work, and relax in a protected and vibrant environment.



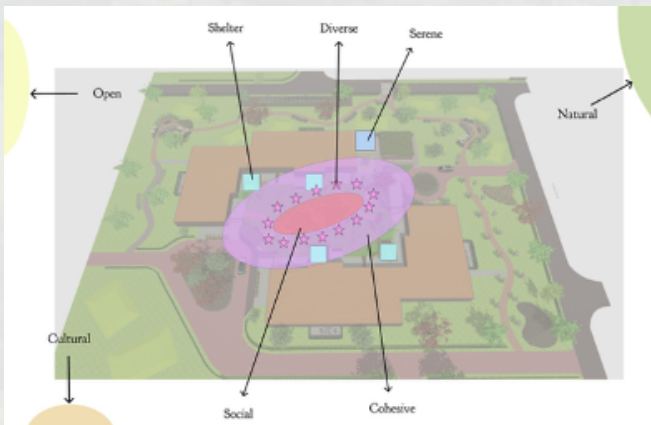
Noorderhaven (Pilotproject)

Noorderhaven care park is a green, vibrant environment where living, care, and animals come together, surrounded by facilities and located close to Julianadorp and the port of Den Helder.

In 2024, we ran a pilot at Park Noorderhaven in which co-creation played a central role. Working together with care staff, facilities, real estate, and green management, we developed a living environment that truly matters.

This process resulted in:

- **An interactive Toolkit** for applying knowledge in design, care, and management across all care parks in the Netherlands.
- Implementation of **The Eight Percieved Sensory Dimensions** on the residential care parks.
- **A Green Management Plan** developed in collaboration with ecologists.
- A process that serves as a **model** for other care parks in the Netherlands.



Courtyard design

During the pilot project, we contributed to the design process of the courtyard at a new-build location on Park Noorderhaven. In several sessions with project stakeholders, we guided the process and provided expertise on greenery and landscape characteristics. The final courtyard design was created by **J. Winter B.V.**

Implementation

The courtyard reflects the surrounding landscape characteristics. The central area serves as a **Social** meeting space for various client groups, featuring colorful and diverse planting (**Diverse**) that stimulates the senses and creates a pleasant atmosphere.

Around the residences, sheltered areas (**Shelter**) function as private terraces where residents can either retreat for quiet moments or gather with familiar company.



Boldershof

The residences in Druten are located in the heart of the neighborhood, close to amenities, work and daytime activity locations, parks, the river De Waal, and a variety of activities for all ages.

Courtyard design

As part of a new-build development, several sessions were held with care staff to explore the wishes and needs of clients and caregivers regarding the outdoor spaces. Based on this input, a courtyard was designed in which the landscape characteristics of the surrounding area are clearly reflected.

Inspiratieontwerp

The design also deliberately focused on preserving existing greenery, ensuring that the space retains its mature and natural character. This results in a vibrant, green courtyard that encourages social interaction, relaxation, and everyday use.

The concept design is now being developed into a technical drawing, bringing the vision closer to realization.



Willem van den Bergh

A spacious park on the outskirts of Noordwijk, bordering the dunes and the Bollenstreek. Here, people of all ages live, work, learn, and enjoy recreational activities in an environment that encourages social interaction, activity, and relaxation.

Willemstuin

The nearly unused Willemstuin in Noordwijk provided the perfect opportunity to create a garden where all Perceived Sensory Dimensions are represented. Together with a multidisciplinary team, we explored how the garden could be best utilized, including for outdoor therapy and other care activities.

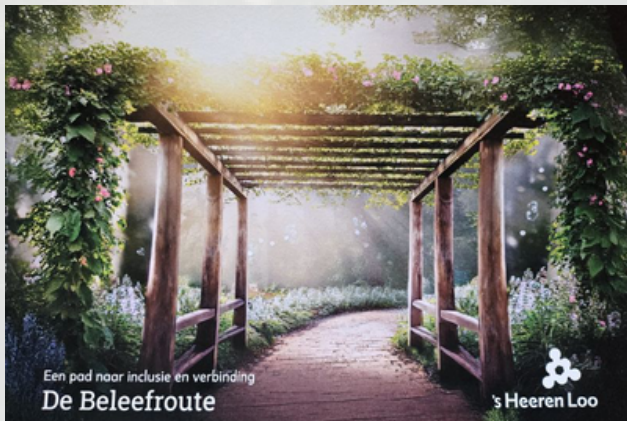
Concept design

The design incorporates almost all landscape characteristics, both within the garden itself and in its immediate surroundings. This garden is unique in the Netherlands, as it can be the first location where all these characteristics converge. The garden is therefore accessible and meaningful for everyone, while simultaneously serving as an example and learning environment for other locations!

Within Apeldoorn Park, knowledge about the landscape is shared in an accessible and playful way, with an imaginative little character guiding visitors to experience nature.



Experience trail

The Eight Percieved Sensory Dimensions are incorporated in an engaging way along the Experience Trail that runs through the park. Along the trail, imaginative little creatures, the 'Struifelaars', guide visitors through eight different landscapes. Informative signs tell stories that make each landscape playful and interactive.

Storybook

In addition, a storybook has been developed that continues the adventures of the 'Struifelaars'. The book will be available in the park shop, inviting visitors to enjoy the story at home or on the go. In this way, nature is experienced in a playful manner, allowing visitors to connect with the green space in a whole new way.
